Another sign that something is wrong is bad smells in the yard or near the drains. If you smell sewage, it's a clear sign that the septic tank is full or the system isn't working right.

People often ignore gurgling sounds coming from drains or toilets inside the house, but these sounds could mean that your septic system is having problems. When the tank is full, pressure builds up, and those sounds are a sign that you need to act fast.

The most obvious sign is when sewage backs up into the house. If wastewater starts to back up into sinks, tubs, or toilets, you need to call for help right away. This usually happens when pumping hasn't been done for too long.
